



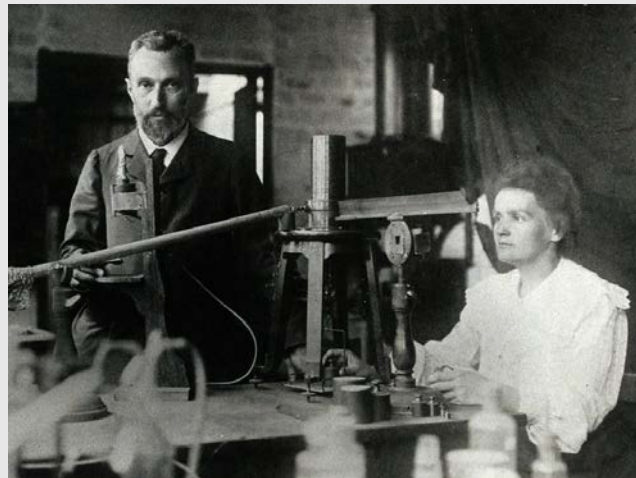
MADAME CURIE

Marie Curie was born in Warsaw, Poland. Her parents were both teachers and they taught her many things in her childhood. Despite the fact that it was against the law for girls to go to school in her country, she still went to a secret school and later she even attended to college in Paris. Curie loved to teach poor children how to read since she thought that all people should be well educated.



She married a man named Pierre Curie who she met in Paris during her journey to becoming a famous Professor. Together the couple performed the discovery of a radioactive substance which was used to invent the World's first X-Ray. Later in her life, when her husband passed away due to a fatal accident, she took his place as a University Professor.



She died in 1934 at the age of 67 of what is known as an unknown disease. There are theories to this day that her illness was caused from her massive exposure to radiation in her life.
