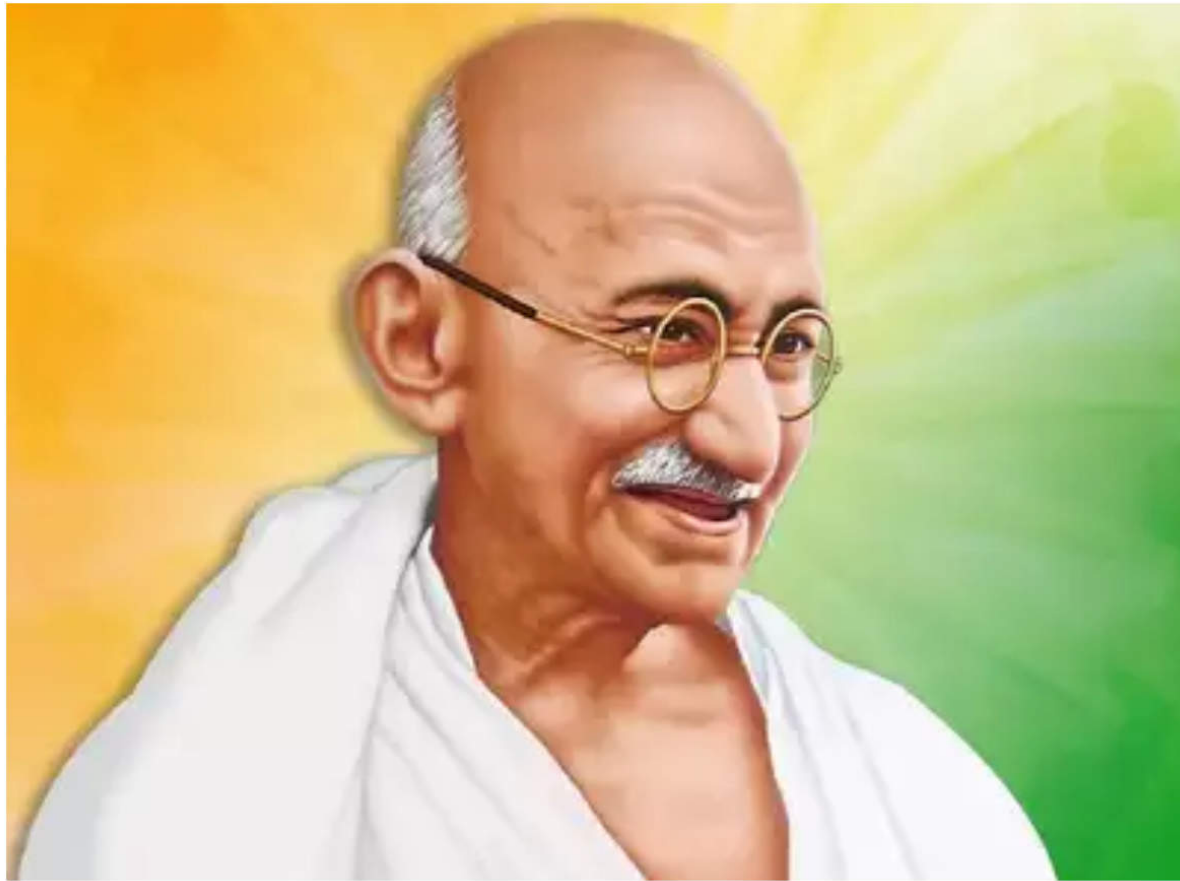


Mahatma Gandhi



- Mahatma Gandhi was born on 2nd October 1869 in Porbander in western India.
- In 1887 he finished his studies at the university of Bombay and moved to England to study law.
- In 1893 Gandhi went to south Africa to help people achieve freedom and equality for all.
- Gandhi was an Indian political and spiritual leader.
- Gandhi used non violent methods to protest.
- His efforts earned him the title Mahatma which means 'Great soul'.

- During world war 2 he was imprisoned for two years because he was working hard to get India's independence.
- India finally won its independence in 1947.
- On January 30th 1948, in the city of Delhi, he was shot and killed by a Hindu man.
- They celebrate his birthday as a National holiday in India.
- Gandhi was admired by many influential people such as Albert Einstein, Nelson Mandela and Martin Luther King, Jr.
